As 2016 comes to a close, please make sure to submit your Doctor/Dentist visits, and/or accident bills, for any eligible treatment that occurred this calendar year. If you are enrolled in the plan, remember: a

single enrollee qualifies for \$100.00 reimbursements (up to two times) for any eligible (non-accident) physician/dentist treatment that occurred in 2016. Families can submit up to four times for the \$100.00 reimbursement, with a maximum of two per individual.

To submit the claim form, fax the provider's bill showing the day(s) of treatment to: American Heritage Life Insurance Company (the fax number is included on the form). Forms can be accessed on the S: Drive in the "Employee HR Forms" folder, and are also available in Director of HR Steve Maloy's office. If you have any questions or need help submitting the paperwork, see Mr. Maloy.

As a reminder, for those of you who are enrolled in the additional policy for Cancer Illness coverage, you may qualify for an additional \$100.00 wellness reimbursement under that plan.

For those employees covered by GDC's health insurance, remember to take advantage of Anthem's member incentives!


